TAKE THE STREETS ON MAY DAY FOR HEALTH, NOT PROFIT!

On the day of unity, struggle and solidarity of the working class on May 1, we are entering a period of intense attacks on workers, laborers, women and youth. As the crisis of the system deepens, the attacks intensify. In whole Europe; this attack, in which dismissals, cutting wages and increasing working hours in many production areas such as iron and steel, electro metal, service sector, will bring together an intense unemployment and impoverishment. There was already a systematic attack, especially on healthcare professionals. While the situation of health workers has already worsened with the privatization, subcontracting, flexibility of working hours and cutting the wages in the health sector, it has turned into a lump of problems with the pandemic. It became clear once again that the system does not care about human health and that its main purpose is more profit.

The system itself is responsible for the pandemic!

Many new viruses have emerged in the world due to the systematic pollution of nature and the lack of emphasis on research and investigation in the field of health. The "fight" against these viruses, which have been occurring one after another for years, is continued only through the pharmaceutical industry. The deterioration of the balances in nature is ignored. Especially in order to increase the profits of pharmaceutical monopolies, they are making benefits from human health. Since the emergence of the corona pandemic; according to official data, 140 million people in the world have been infected with the virus. 3 million people died worldwide, including 1 million in Europe. However, it is a fact that the real number is much higher. With the emergence of the virus, despite the intense demands for stopping production in all factories, except for essential production in many geographies, it was not taken seriously and the production continued. Despite the physical measures imposed under the name of precaution in the streets and homes, the fact that the factories, which are the areas where the virus is mostly infected, are not closed, is another indicator that the system is profit-based. Therefore, the current system is responsible for the high number of infections and the number of people who lost their lives.

The pharmaceutical industry is supported, not human health!

The system is based on excess profit instead of human health, which is due to its imperialist character. Thus, with the invention of the vaccine, imperialist countries have almost started a race for more profits. On the one hand, mass vaccination is mentioned, on the other hand, vaccines are left under the control of pharma monopolies. The first 5 monopolies producing vaccines have so far earned over 60 Billion Euros. The patents of the vaccine are obtained by big monopolies and the transportation for the people of poor countries is virtually prevented. Only 20 percent of the vaccine produced so far has reached the deferred countries, the rest remained in the imperialist countries. Vaccines cannot be produced in other countries, especially because monopolies do not grant patent rights. Therefore, the peoples of the world are openly left to die.

Let's walk along the bright path of the Paris Communards!

In these days, where we are approaching May Day, new restrictions are being discussed in all European countries. Despite the restrictions, but with paying attention to health conditions, we should defend our rights with street protests on May Day, against imperialist aggression, dismissals, new security laws with fascistic content, and the fact that the rulers give priority to the profits instead of human health. The resistance of the Paris communards of 150 years ago, which has been carried out street by street, neighborhood by neighborhood, house by house, should be an example to us today.

Because we have nothing to lose but chains, but they have a lot to lose!
